Psychodrama in one-to-one Therapy

This weekend will explore the use of psychodrama techniques in one-to-one therapy. It is open to psychodrama trainees, practitioners and other psychotherapists and counsellors who would like to explore including action methods in their work

Enhancing Emotional Expression

This workshop will be focussed on enabling trainees and practitioners of psychodrama to incorporate some of the techniques from psychodramatic bodywork to enhance the cathartic experience of the protagonist. It is also an opportunity for people who have experience of psychodramatic bodywork to see how this can be incorporated into classical psychodrama.

This workshop will demonstrate the use of psychodrama and action methods with children and adolescents. It is aimed at people who work with children in a therapeutic or educational setting and would like to develop their skills.

Role Development

MAIN WORKSHOP LEADERS

Most workshops are run by two members of the OSPIP training team. The residentials in May and November are run jointly with the Birmingham Institute for Psychodrama, Susie Taylor and Clark Baim.

Peter Haworth

Peter works as a specialist team therapist at the Complex Needs Service in Milton Keynes. He is registered as a Senior Trainer of Psychodrama with the British Psychodrama Association. He is a founder member and Honorary President of the British Psychodrama Association. He currently represents the BPA at the United Kingdom Council for Psychotherapy.

Nancy Piercy

Nancy works as a Clinical Nurse Specialist at the Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service in Gloucestershire. She is registered as a Trainer of Psychodrama with the British Psychodrama Association and is a member of its Executive Committee. She co-facilitates a psychodrama group for adults in private practice and also works as a supervisor.

PSYCHODRAMA DIPLOMA COURSE

From October 2010, OSPIP will be starting a new advanced diploma course. This exciting new project that we are hoping will lead to validation by the University of Worcester and will lead to an MSc in Psychodrama Psychotherapy. The course will have a total of nine modules taught over 4-5 years. The course will be divided into 3 stages, a post graduate certificate, post graduate diploma and the advanced diploma (MSc if the partnership with Worcester proceeds as planned). There will be a maximum of 12 places on this new course and applications are invited via our website. The course handbook will be available from the beginning of May 2010.

Modules are: Foundations of Psychodrama, Challenging and Enhancing Practice, Group Psychotherapy and Sociometry, Theories of Child Development, Research Methods and Planning, Advanced Clinical Practice and a 3 module research project and dissertation.

REGISTRATION

All workshops and groups except for residential will be held in the Complex Needs Service, Oxford Therapeutic Community Building in Manzil Way off Cowley Road in Oxford. The May and November residential workshops will be held at the Asha Centre in the forest of Dean

Applications should be made in writing, to Oxford School of Psychodrama and Integrative Psychotherapy, 8 Rahere Road, Littlemore, Oxford OX4 3QG. The application should include the **non-refundable deposit of £50** or the full fee which is due seven days before the start of the group.

People cancelling within 48 hours of the start of the group will not be entitled to a refund. Except for residential workshops, accommodation is not provided, but details of Bed and Breakfast and Youth Hostels will be sent on application.

PSYCHODRAMATIC BODYWORK ®

Psychodramatic bodywork was developed by Susan Aaron from Toronto in Canada. There are training courses held in this country at Introductory, Intermediate and Advanced level. The training combines psychodrama with aspects of Shiatsu and Reiki, enhancing the use of both the body and the spiritual components of classical psychodrama.

Some of our workshops will include aspects of psychodramatic bodywork and we recommend that people attend both the Introductory and Intermediate level trainings as an enhancement to psychodrama training with OSPIP.
