Weekend Training Workshops on using the SCID II Structured Clinical Interview for DSMIV Personality Disorders

May 22nd/23rd and September 18th/19th 2010

The course is run by Lisle Scott, Team Psychiatrist, Oxford Complex Needs Service and Peter Haworth, Senior Trainer, OSPIP

There are a maximum of 12 places that will be allocated on a first come first served basis.

Main Aims:

To become more familiar with the categories of personality disorder in DSMIV and ICD10.

To learn to use the SCID II questionnaire and Structured Interview and to critically understand its use both individually and in groups.

There will be presentations by the workshop leaders on Personality Disorder diagnosis, the use of the SCID questionnaire and structured interview and some of the difficult diagnostic conundrums between Axis I and Axis II disorders. These workshops will also include the special use of the SCID interview in groups as developed in the Oxford Therapeutic Community.

Participants will be sent a copy of the SCID II questionnaire prior to the workshop and will need to be able to ask one of their patients/clients to fill it in. Further information will be provided following acceptance and payment of the course fees.

A large part of the weekend will involve the role-play of interviews involving course leaders and participants.

The workshop will run from 10am to 5pm on Saturday and Sunday. Tea and coffee and lunches will be provided on both days. The lunch breaks will also provide opportunities for networking.
